Due to an editorial error, several sentences were printed incorrectly. The corrected versions follow.

Page 198, third paragraph of Results, seventeenth line. The sentence should read:  
"It is possible that either the 59- or the 61-kD protein is CAB-63 (calregulin) (23)."

Page 198, legend to Fig. 1, ninth line. The sentence should read:  
"Calcium proteins of apparent molecular masses 94, 61, and 59 kD are indicated by arrowheads."

Page 199, first paragraph of Discussion, eleventh line. The sentence should read:  
"It is not clear whether either of the two proteins of 59 and 61 kD detected by the  $^{45}\text{Ca}$  overlay assay and Stains All is related to calsequestrin, which has been previously detected by anti-calsequestrin sera in nonmuscle cells (8, 22)."
