


FIGURE 3. Examination of TCR β chains by Southern analysis. Above is a genomic restriction enzyme diagram for the region encoding the TCR V β 8 (11a, 27) genes and the region encoding TCR D β , J β , and C β genes (28). Individual DNA probes used are indicated below. All clones are KJ16⁺ except PjR-6.4. (a) DNA was digested with restriction enzyme Xba I and hybridized with probe V β C5.1, a 280-bp Pst-Pvu II subclone of V β 8.1 (V β C5.1 [reference 11]). (b) Each DNA sample was digested with Xba I and hybridized with DNA probe 5'V β C5.2, a 0.5-kb Pvu II fragment, located 2 kb 5' of V β 8.2 (see restriction map). (c) DNA was digested with Hind III and hybridized with V β C5.1. (d) DNA samples were digested with Hind III and hybridized with a 1.2-kb J β 2 genomic probe (12) encompassing J β 2.1-2.7. V β 5.1, which is not shown, is located between V β 8.3 and V β 8.2 (27).
