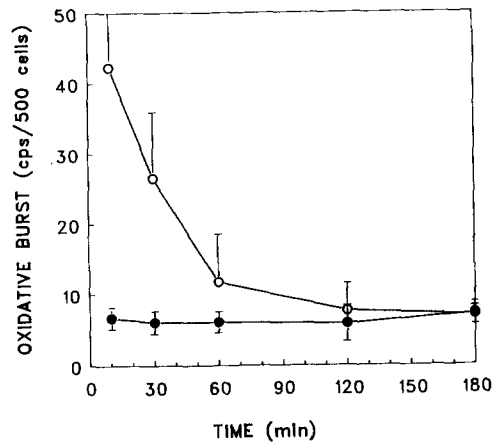


In the article "Impairment of macrophage functions after ingestion of *Plasmodium falciparum*-infected erythrocytes or isolated malarial pigment" by E. Schwarzer, F. Turrini, U. Ulliers, G. Giribaldi, H. Ginsburg, and P. Arese (October 1992, 176:1033), the symbols in the legend to Figure 3 were reversed. The corrected legend and figure appear below.



**Figure 3.** Initial oxidative burst induced by pigment presented to monocytes. Suspended monocytes were fed with pigment (O) at time 0, briefly spun down, resuspended, and stored at 37°C in a CO<sub>2</sub> incubator. About  $2.5 \times 10^5$  cells were pipetted at different times in the test tube and analyzed for luminescence in presence of luminol. For details see Materials and Methods. Control monocytes without pigment (●) were treated similarly. Data shown are means  $\pm$ SD of eight experiments.
