


Figure 2. Impaired LAT phosphorylation and interaction with PLCγ1 and Grb-2 in TSAd-deficient T cells. LN T cells from TSAd (+/+) and (–/–) mice were stimulated with optimal concentrations of CD3 and CD28 mAb for the indicated times (in min). (A) PLCγ1 activation was assessed by Western blotting of whole cell lysates using a phospho-specific antibody.

Also, Fig. 2 contained a labeling error. In panels A and B, all instances of “100” should have read “150.” The corrected figure and its legend appear below.
